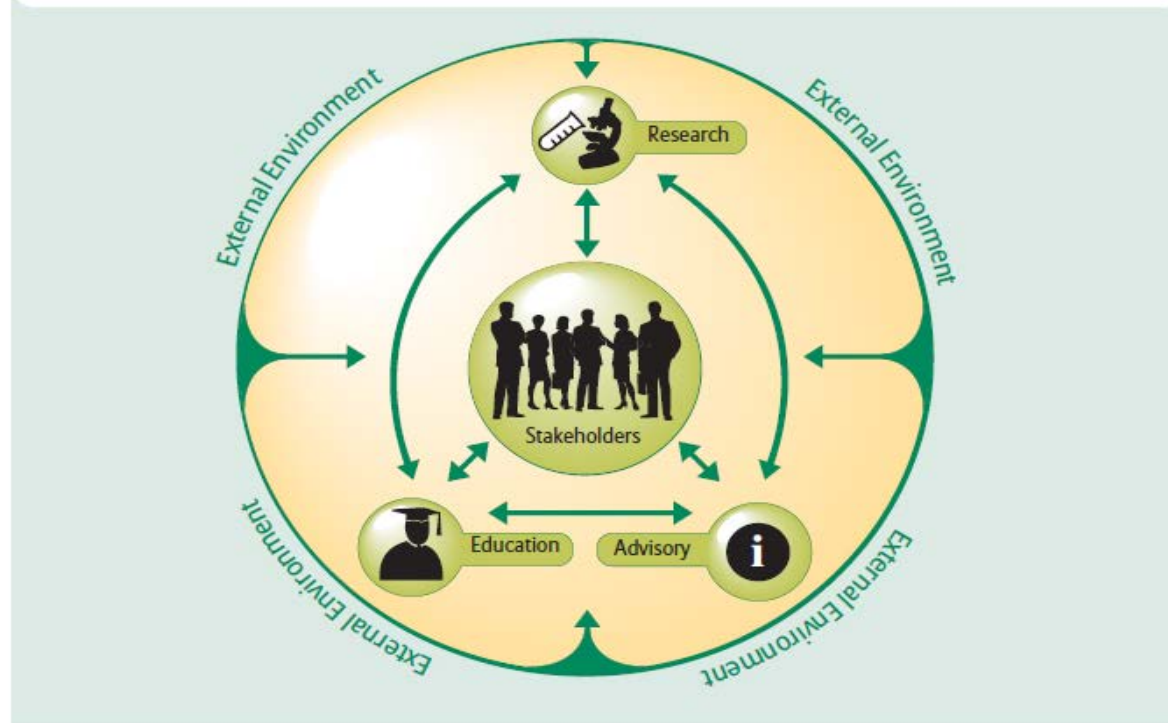

Figure 1 Teagasc Model of Knowledge Delivery

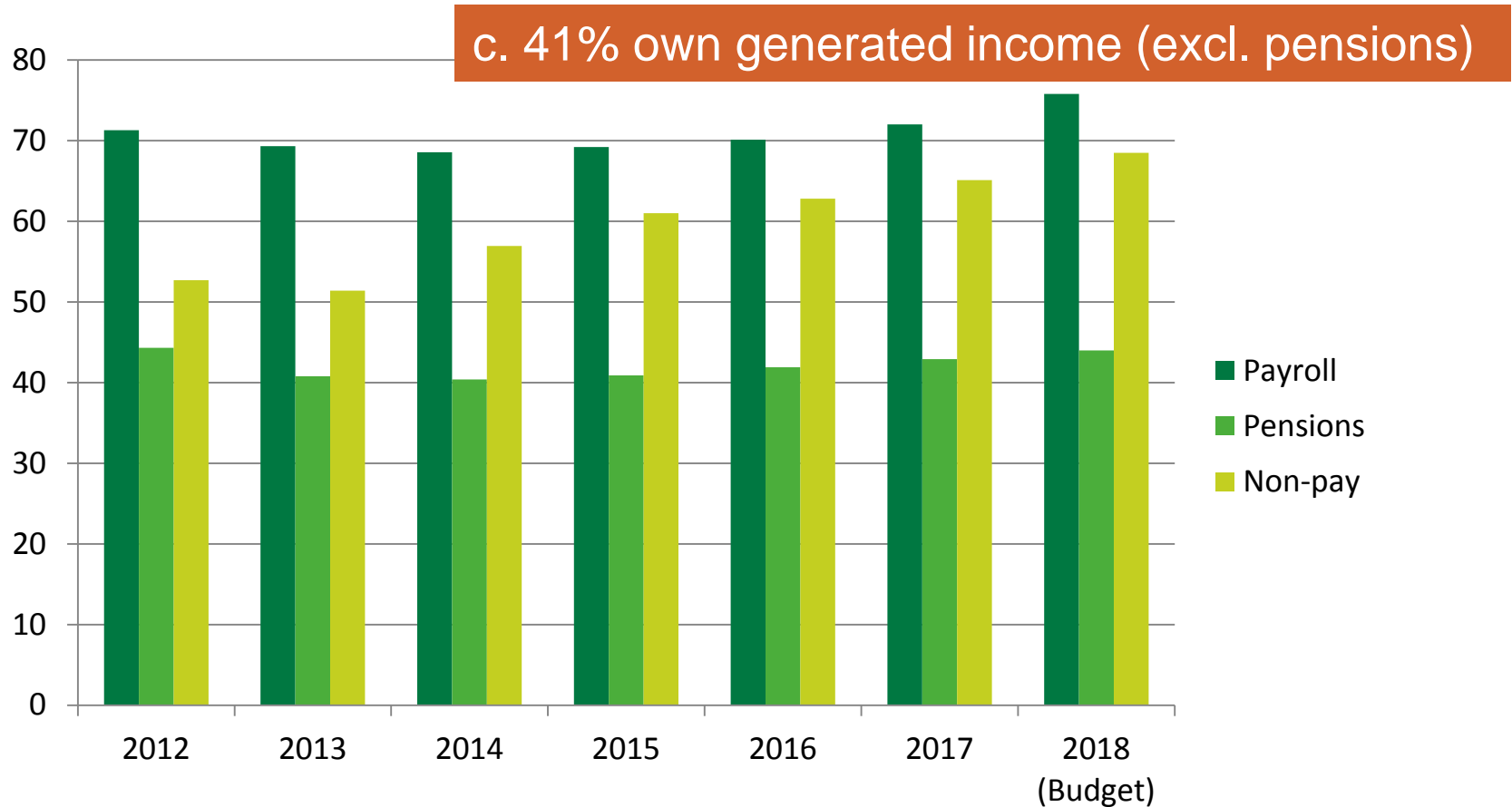


Teagasc sites map

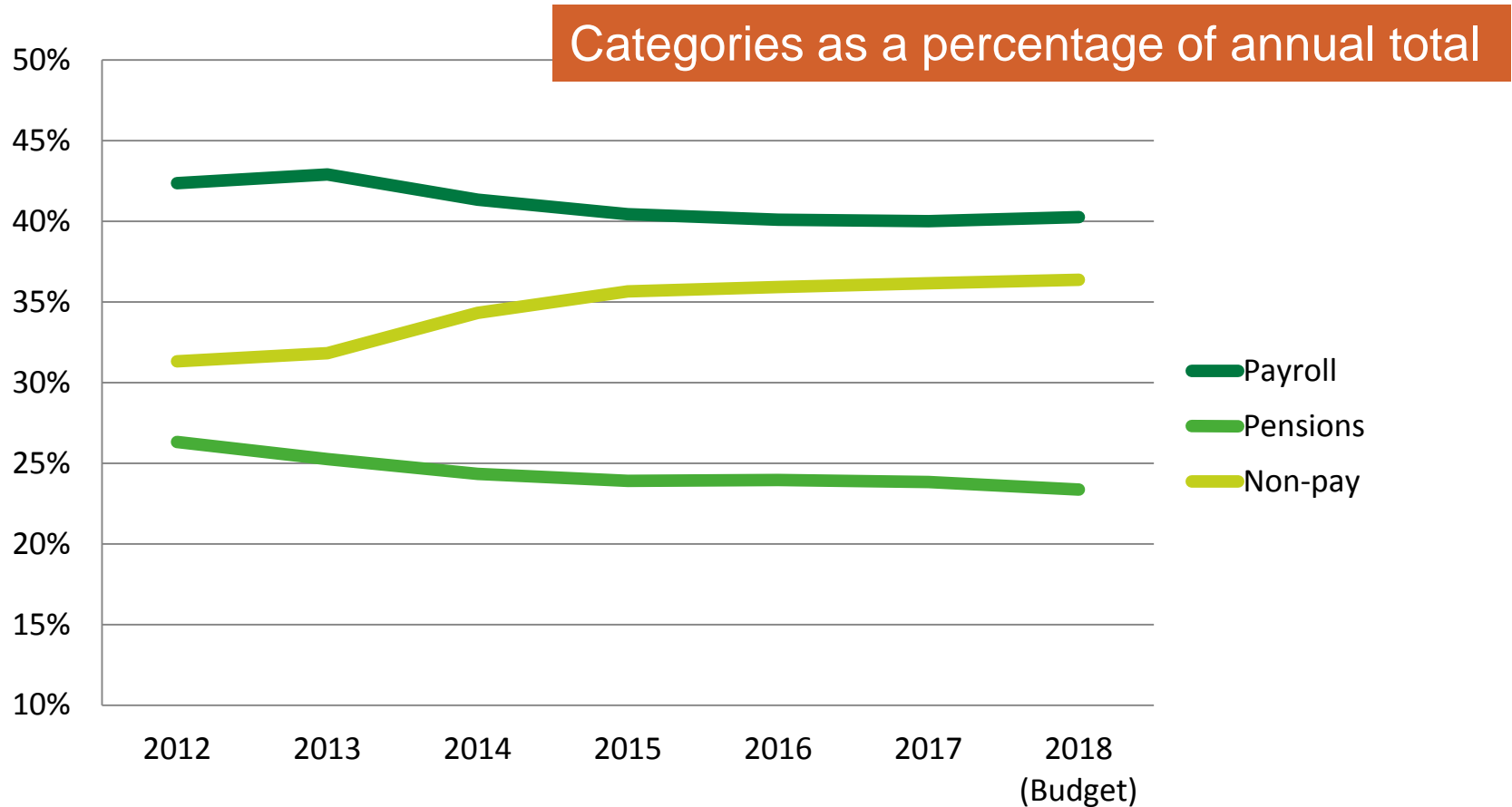

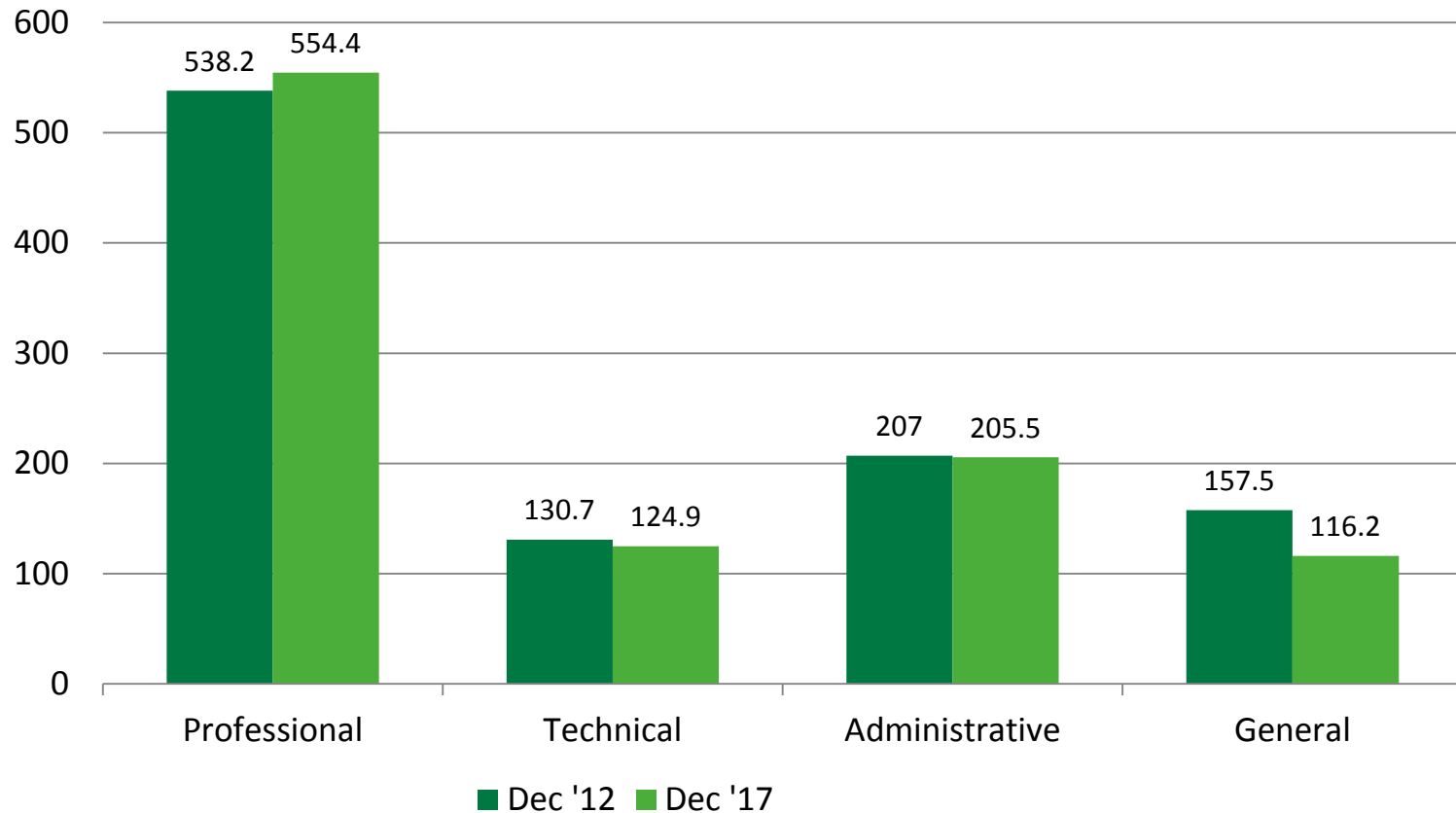
