


Avian Influenza outbreak

3km Protection Zone


10km Surveillance Zone


3km Captive Bird (Monitoring) Controlled Zone


Regional Avian Influenza Prevention Zone


Avian Influenza Prevention Zone South West

Why was the 2021-23 outbreak so bad?

- Survivability?
- Lower amount of virus needed to infect birds?
- Greater ability to infect waterfowl?
- Airborne spread?

How did we tackle it?

- Most cases were fresh introductions and not spread between farms!
- Avian Influenza Prevention Zone.
- Housing Order.
- 3k and 10k zones.
- Licensing requirements for moving birds to and from farms in zones.
- Messaging!
- Stakeholder meetings!
